Liberty boasts an impressive layout designed to maximise space and comfort, accommodating up to eight berths. Starting from the stern, you enter the Rear Cabin, which offers two single beds. This cabin is perfect for guests or family members, providing a cosy and private sleeping area. The well-insulated cabin ensures a comfortable environment regardless of the weather, thanks to its polystyrene insulation and Webasto central heating system.

Moving forward, you'll find the first Bathroom. This bathroom is equipped with a macerator toilet, a stylish countertop basin with ample under-basin storage, and a spacious shower. The modern fixtures and efficient layout make this a convenient space for daily use.

Next is the Bunk Beds Room, a versatile area featuring bunk beds with side storage. This room is ideal for children or additional guests, offering plenty of storage for personal items and ensuring everyone has their own space.

Liberty is moored at the picturesque Caen Hill Marina in Wiltshire, offering stunning views and a peaceful environment. The boat's internal cabin height of $196\,\mathrm{cm}$ provides a spacious feel, while the side hatch located on the portside forward cabin adds to the ventilation and accessibility.

With three leisure batteries and one starter battery, Liberty ensures a reliable power supply. The electric system includes both 12v and 240v from an inverter, catering to all your electrical needs. Hot water is supplied from the engine, and cabin heating is provided by four radiators, ensuring comfort throughout the year. The boat also comes with two 13kg gas cylinders, supporting the galley's cooking facilities.

Liberty, with its adaptable space and charming cruiser stern, is perfect for those seeking adventure on Britain's inland waterways. It offers ample room for social gatherings, making it an ideal party boat for weekends and holidays.
